Checklist of Pueblo Area Birds -- Alphabetical Order -- (Compiled 2023)

This publication is sponsored by the Arkansas Valley Audubon Society (AVAS). Its scope covers the following Colorado counties: Pueblo, Fremont, Custer, Huerfano, Otero, and Crowley. Systematic research of bird distribution in the Pueblo Area was begun by a few enthusiastic birders in the 1960's. This checklist is the work of many, thanks to the rapidly growing interests in birds.

The diverse habitat of our area includes mountains, large lakes, riparian, and cactus-sage habitats. Thus, many different birds are attracted to the area contributing to changing patterns of distribution and new additions to our checklist (443 species as of early March 2023). This checklist was compiled by Brandon Percival and Van Truan with the aid of Richard Tucey.
